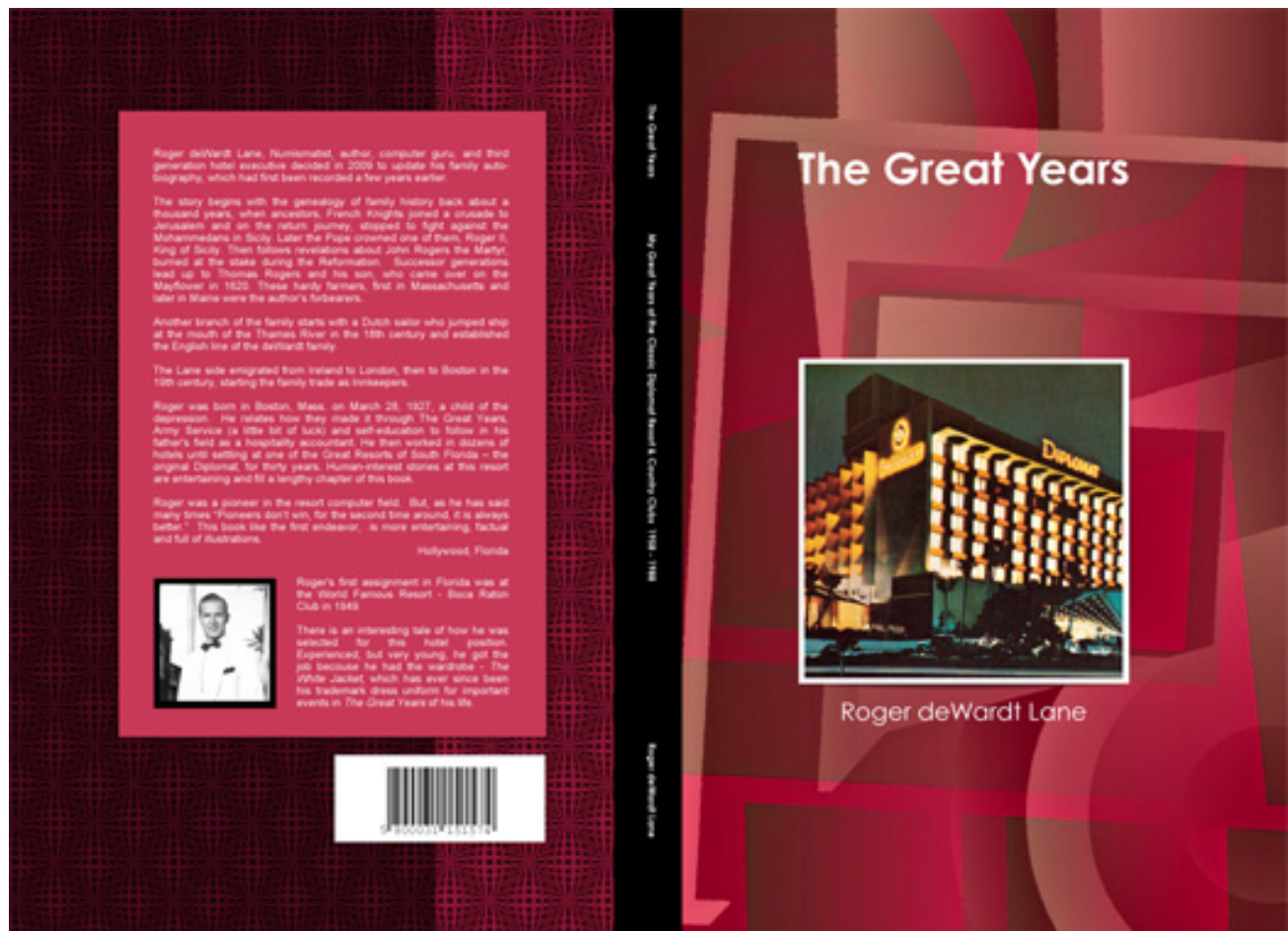
*To Start with **MuttTheDimeMan** has written his life story which has been posted on his Web Site.*
